3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Vote by Mail Tracking5 Act".

SEC. 2. MAIL-IN BALLOTS AND POSTAL SERVICE BARCODE SERVICE.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3001 of title 39, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing:

6 "(p) Any ballot sent within the United States for an
7 election for Federal office is nonmailable and shall not be
8 carried or delivered by mail unless the ballot is mailed in
9 an envelope that—

"(1) contains a Postal Service barcode (or successive service or marking) that enables tracking of
each individual ballot;

13 "(2) satisfies requirements for ballot envelope
14 design that the Postal Service may promulgate by
15 regulation;

"(3) satisfies requirements for machineable letters that the Postal Service may promulgate by regulation; and

"(4) includes the Official Election Mail Logo
(or any successor label that the Postal Service may
establish for ballots).".

(b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to any election for Federal office
occurring after the date of enactment of this Act.
